**Teacher Presentation**– Brandy Lechner - Online learning new provincial corporation to start next year. They are going centralized but only applies to public school divisions. Started with Sunwest's model, passed out booklets to look through. Very much paper based but well thought out. Concerns for staffing and still a question mark for the new program. It will be staffed by qualified teachers. Saskatchewan Distance Learning Corporation being offered K-12 you need to apply and be accepted. This program will be free unlike Flex Ed that requires at least a registration fee. A benefit is for small schools where students may need a class not offered and could take it online.
