- Report cards are going to be switched in the future to being published for viewing (gradebook) rather than printing them out.

**Continued Business**

- SCC Training Module – ELearning Professional Development GSSD – Kendra will post link and will prep questions to discuss at the next meeting.
- Hot Lunch March 23 confirmed from Rail City – Chicken strips, mac n cheese, carrot and celery, cookie - \$10 per meal (Rail City charge \$8). Forms are in, Melissa will reconcile cash and e transfers with form then get cash to Stacey. Melissa will let Nicole know how many orders per class and Nicole will relay that information to Rail City. Kathy will pick up and deliver to school.

- One Book One School – launches tomorrow (March 14) – doing live readings Tuesdays and Thursdays at 7pm. They may need a volunteer from the SCC to do a reading (Melissa) but will let us know if we can help in any way. Short book so it will be done by easter break.
- Fundraising Update
  - Raffle Discussion – Nicole – Jeff is on board with whatever, \$200-300 to purchase a bike. They will be willing to sell the tickets, but in the past, they haven't typically sold many tickets at the store in. He also had some clearance items that we could purchase as other prizes. Patio Heater \$150 for 2<sup>nd</sup> prize was an option. Discuss \$2 tickets, book of 10. Prepay per book for those who are taking away to sell. Sell them at school, SRC, gas station and anyone that would like to sell.
    - Raffle for Outdoor Playground enhancements - Carma ***motions*** \$2500 lottery license - 1250 tickets for \$2 each. Spend up to \$500 for prizes. Draw date May 30<sup>th</sup> 10am. Melissa *seconds. All in Favor.* **Motion carried.**  
 Timeline – get info from home hardware by next week. Aim to print tickets next week. Officially start selling tickets the week of April 3<sup>rd</sup>  
 Prizes – 1<sup>st</sup> Bike valued up to \$300, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> options – valued at \$150 and \$50.  
 Small print – winner will be provided a gift card to use for the bike or something else.  
 Kathy will get the lottery license, Nicole will contact Home Hardware to confirm prizes, Darla will print the tickets. Kendra or Esther will make up the raffle tickets (to be confirmed once all information is in).
  - Coop BBQ – Melissa – June 2, 10am-2pm– they have a brand-new BBQ and it will need to be cleaned properly after usage – Need to bring own utensils and coolers. Purchase all supplies at COOP. Rena and Carma will work the BBQ. Kendra and Kathy will check their schedules. Esther can help from 10-12. Carma will make a poster to advertise for the BBQ.
  - Bingo – Kendra – still playing phone tag and trying to get a hold of the legion.

#### New Business

- Student Led Conferences (Mar 22 & 23) – coop meat tray and buns for both days for 11 teachers. Melissa will phone ahead and place order for 20 people and can charge it to the SCC Coop account. Melissa will pick up on the 22<sup>nd</sup> as well. Up to \$250 budget.
