- Update on Events/Activities

 - Fitness Fridays – Esther will reach out to Karen and Carma to begin a morning family pack alternating activity hopefully in March.
 - Food Drive – Dog Pack Challenge - Easter basket give away raffle for Davison School families. Aim to get started in March for collection prior to Easter break. We would need some big boxes for each dog pack (4) – Melissa will source some boxes, Darla and Esther

will get them set up. We could do a donut party or something similar as a reward. Notification should go out by March 4th – Jill and Kendra will get a poster together. Collection would be from March 11th-22nd. Baskets will be made prior to March 28th for a draw give away – the number of baskets will be determined by how many supplies.

- Hot Lunch – McDonald's Feb 14th postponed for an alternate KB day due to STF sanctions. New proposed date **Friday, Mar 22**. Order forms would go out Mar 6th and be collected by Mar 13th. We would charge \$7 per happy meal.
- Fundraising Plan
 - Fersters Market – Orange and Grapefruit fundraiser cancelled as Away we Grow Daycare started the fundraiser the day before we had planned. We could try again next year.
 - Mitchell's Soups – dried soups made in Canada. 35% from each sale. \$10.99 for a soup that feeds a family of 4. No cost to do anything. Has a product catalogue. Items are non-perishable. We would like to try it Mar 27th – April 15th. Jill will reach out to the company this week to get the full details and set up those dates. We would need 135 catalogues. We would need have the orders delivered to the school and sort them as is done for Mom's Pantry. Can students name be part of the selling information. How does the report come from Mitchell's to see who has sold how much. We could put each student that sells a soup into a raffle for a prize. Finalize information at our next meeting and prize specifics at April meeting.
 - Multicultural event – Jill spoke about the amount of work that would go into it, the places that might be needed. If it is not something we need to do to raise money for the outdoor playground pathway, it would be nice to try again another day.
- Outdoor Pathway – Jill received some quotes - Terry Freisen quotes 50% of his labor cost. Home hardware would donate all the rebar we would need. David who owns E&H would donate all the packing gravel. Jill may have her company donate more gravel. Jill is going to reach out to the Painted Hand casino for a grant to pay for some of the labour. Kendra is looking at the grant application to help fill in some questions Jill has. If we could get a parent or two to volunteer to assist, it would narrow down the labour costs. Jill will send Kathy some information to pass on to the Teamsters local TCRC division 764 for their next meeting for a possible donation. Once all the plans are in place, Darla can go to the board to get approval. SCC would pay for a sign to advertise for the donation. Darla will get a dollar amount for how much is already allocated for the playground project. It would be a 4-day project.
