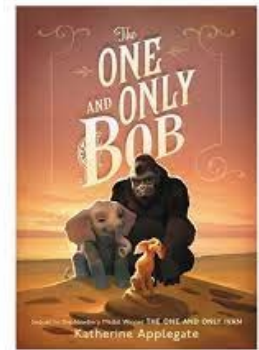

We would like to thank our wonderful, hardworking SCC board for spoiling the staff of Davison School all week long. As you can see the staff room table had many delicious treats.





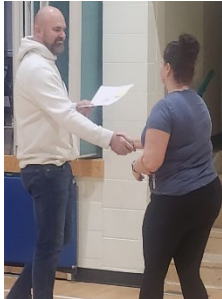
## **Service Recognition Awards**
