- Touch based on the Alternate School week calendar. The school division is still exploring, there has been some success in communities with high support. There are still challenges within Melville regarding the interdependencies with the schools and childcare within the community.

- SCC Grant Loans – division offers loans (pay back loan 25% up front first – \$5000-100000) particularly for playground equipment. They are on the website. Kendra will send us the policy.

### **New Business**

- Melville Youth Council – The Youth Council came to visit this evening. Proposal – The youth council’s focus is on development and youth recreation. They have an initiative program “School fuel” for nutrition at the Melville schools. They are looking for support letter from the SCC to support them in grant applications. Their hope is that each school would receive \$5000 if they reach their goal. This money would be to support a program to promote nutrition, provide nutritional resources and help feed students in need with nutritious meals and snacks. They may apply for one or two grants “Breakfast Clubs of Canada” and Mosaic School Nutrition Challenge. The initiative program would begin with the start of the next school year. They are also hoping to do a school supply drive again this summer. Esther will write up a letter of support on behalf of the Davison SCC.
