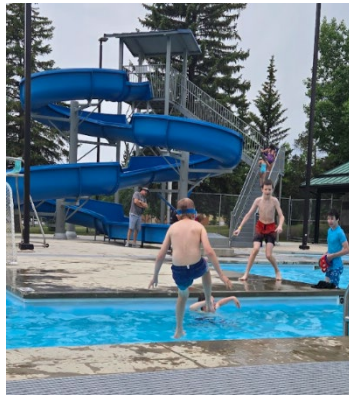
Melville Fire Department Visit Davison School
