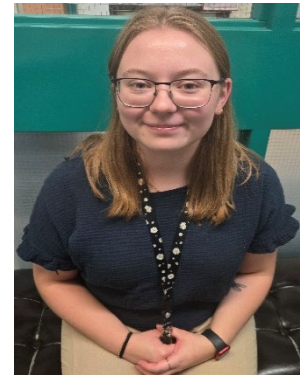
A big thank you to **Tamra Weber**. She has already made sure we don't run out of homemade muffins for our breakfast program.

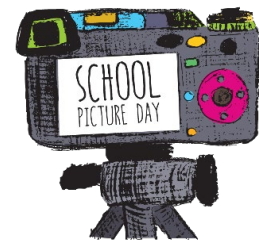
### Davison Dairy

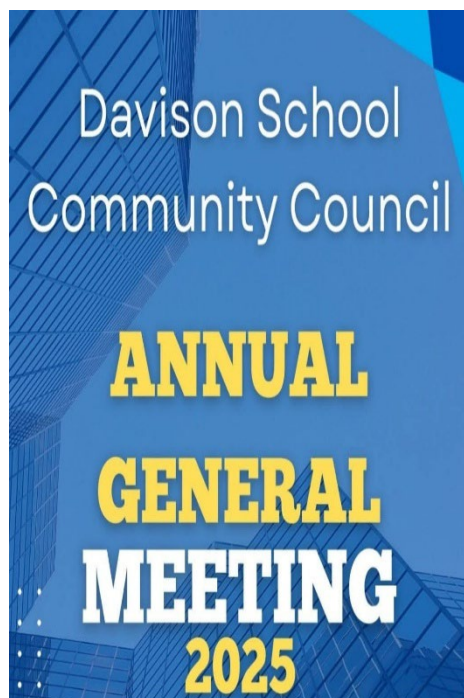

Marks for students in Grade 1 – 6 will be in **Gradebook** in Edsby. Parents will receive a notification when a mark has been posted for their child/children (if notifications are turned on). Please make sure you are signed up for Edsby and have access to Gradebook.
